

Every year, Orange County California Genealogical Society (“OCCGS”) sponsors a week-long Research Trip to the Family History Library in Salt Lake City, Utah. This trip provides an exceptional opportunity to use the extensive resources of the largest depository of genealogical reference material in the world for your personal genealogy research.

You must be an OCCGS member to participate in the trip. Before we leave on our trip, we provide orientation meetings to help you prepare for a successful experience, including how to use what’s available at the library, and how to get ready for the trip with a research plan for your work when you arrive in Salt Lake City. Whether you are visiting the Family History Library for the first time or are a seasoned researcher, join us for this exciting opportunity!

When in Salt Lake City, your package includes:

- **Seven nights at the Salt Lake Plaza Hotel** next to the Family History Library (Sunday night thru Saturday Night, check out on Sunday, March 27th).
- **SIX FULL DAYS OF RESEARCH** (Monday thru Saturday) at the Family History Library.
- **Research Guidance** from experienced OCCGS Members and Staff Genealogists at the Library.
- **Monday Evening Banquet** with Guest Speaker.
- **Group All-You-Can-Eat Breakfast** on Saturday, March 28th.
- **Complimentary Airport Shuttle** provided by the hotel, or you can ride the TRAX light rail system that drops you a short walk directly across the street from the hotel for a nominal fee.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- You are responsible for your own transportation to Salt Lake City.
- A reservation deposit of \$100.00 must be accompanied with this form (or a copy).
- Final Payment is Due by Saturday February 1, 2022.
- All checks must be made payable to "OCCGS."
- The IRS requires participants must be a member of OCCGS – see membership flyer for dues.
- Individual cancellations must be received by the Saturday, February 1, 2022 OCCGS meeting. Refunds for cancellations after February 1 are based upon the hotel's refund policy, PLUS a \$50.00 handling charge for OCCGS.
- No reductions for fewer days stay at the hotel.
- When rooms are filled, a \$100 deposit will put you on a standby list.
- OCCGS is not liable for personal sickness or injury, nor loss or damage to personal property.
- Baggage is "at owner's risk" throughout the trip, unless otherwise insured.
- OCCGS offers SLC Research Trip classes prior to the Trip: Although not mandatory, attendance is encouraged. Class content includes Research Preparation and Travel Preparations, Handy Packing Hints (including What *Not* to Take), How to Dress, Where to Eat, etc.
- Room Differences: A Deluxe Room is a little larger than the Standard Room, and Deluxe Rooms are on the "front" side of the hotel. Deluxe Rooms have 2 sinks where the Standard Room has only 1 sink. All Standard Rooms are on the "back" side of the hotel. If you require an ADA-Compliant / Handicapped Accessible room, Deluxe Room rates will apply.
