- John F. Boughman born in Richland County, Ohio and Shoemaker by profession joined Co A, 47 IL US INF CON as a Private on 21 July 1862 for a period of 3 years. Discharged 20 July 1865

U.S. Civil War Soldiers

- Enlisted 24 July 1862, mustered in 26 September 1862, transferred 28 November 1862 into Company A of the Consolidated 47th Infantry Regiment, mustered out 20 July 1865.
