Ezra C. Burdick may be the son of Joseph Stubbs and Rebecca Unknown, though there is no hard proof. Ezra was living with them in the 1850 Census as Ezra Stubbs, but Rebecca was 51 years of age, probably too old to be his birth mother. They may have taken him in after the death of his parents. In the 1860 Census, Ezra Stubbs was living with Lewis Burdick and Lydia A. Stubbs. Lydia A. Stubbs could be his mother, or a sibling. When he enlisted in 1861, he was Ezra Burdick, and also in the 1870 Census, he had changed his name to Ezra C. Burdick, which he used for the rest of his life. He could have been adopted, or just taken in until he reached legal age. The probate record for Lewis Burdick did not mention Ezra Burdick as an heir when filed on 29 August 1871.

Ezra Burdick enlisted on 9 December 1861 as a Private in D Company of the 38th Ohio Infantry, and mustered on 1 June 1864. The 38th Regiment, Ohio Infantry mustered in September 1, 1861 at Defiance, Ohio. He transferred into D Company of the 7th Regiment Veteran Reserve Corps.

He married Eva Sabina Marshall about 1876, either in Missouri or Kansas.
