Discharged for disability from Co I, 2nd Minnesota Infantry on 10 August 1862

John Bushard's brother Wilfred fought with Co K, 1st Minnesota Heavy Artillery in the Civil War.

John Bushard's son George married Anna Heaston daughter of Civil War Veteran John Heaston also buried in Orange County.

John Bushard's son Louis married Annie Ellis daughter of Civil War Veteran Obediah Ellis also buried in Orange County.

John Bushard's son William married Annie McGowen daughter of Civil War Veteran James McGowen also buried in Orange County.

Bushard Street in Huntington Beach is named for John B. Bushard who farmed on what is now the corner of Bushard Street and Adams Avenue in Huntington Beach. He was a celery and sugar beet farmer.
