Charles's brother George fought with Co E, New York 114th Infantry Regiment during the Civil War. He is buried in Sunnyside Cemetery, Long Beach, California

Charles's grandson Charles T. Chappel, Jr., was in the Quartermaster Corps from 1918 to 1919.
