## Additional Information

Enlisted 4 October 1861 at Albany, New York, suffered a gun shot wound to the right hand during the siege of Port Hudson, Louisiana on 27 May 1863, mustered out 1 October 1864 at New Orleans, Louisiana

George was admitted to the Leavenworth, Kansas Veterans Home on 26 May 1893. He was living in the Home in 1900. The record lists that he was discharged 9 December 1919 (this must be in error as it is after his death date). In 1910 he was living with his niece, Laura Carpenter in Ellsworth, Kansas. He appears to be back in the Home in 1915. His niece, Laura, was living in Orange, Orange County, California in 1930, therefore, George must have come to California with his niece.
