**Andrew Cook's daughter Ella M.** married Milo (Milford) B. Stevens son of George Washington Stevens a Civil War Veteran also buried in Orange County

**Andrew Cook's daughter Annie** married Delmar Woodward son of Chesley Woodward a Civil War Veteran also buried in Orange County

**Andrew's daughter Susannah** married Frank Salter, son of Horace Salter a member of Sedgwick Post No 17 and a veteran of the Mexican War who is also buried in Orange County.

**Cook's Corner** - Wikipedia

The building is named for Andrew Jackson Cook, a merchant and Civil War Veteran who acquired 190 acres of land in the South Orange County area. The building was constructed in 1884. Cook's son, Earl Jack "E.J." Cook, converted the structure into a restaurant to supply food to miners and local ranchers. Cook's was converted into a bar after Prohibition. A Santa Ana, California motorcycle accessories owner purchased the building in 1970, and publicized it further, making it one of the more famous social places for motorcycle owners.
