Civil War Service Records

Enlisted 14 December 1861 at Memphis, Missouri, mustered in 1 February 1862. Wounded in the battle of Corinth October 5, 1862 by a partially spent ball striking him on the forehead. He was unfit for duty and was subject to epileptic fits. He was discharged 21 April 1863 for disability resulting from epilepsy – deafness and partial mental derangement. He was in the U.S.A. Post Hospital, Columbus, Kentucky from January 1863 until April 1863.
