LOCAL INTELLIGENCE.

Executive Pardon. — At the September term of the Justice's Court of the city of San Buenaventura, Ventura county, 1884, Arthur Fitzpatrick. a man 66 years of age. who served 14 years in the American navy, and distinguished himself in several engagements during the war of the rebellion was tried upon two charges of misdemeanor, the burning of nine dollars' worth of the properly of another upon his own premises, and which he claimed was his own. His old-time neighbors and friends took the matter up and presented a petition to the Governor signed by the committing Justice, the Superior Judge, the prosecuting attorney, the District Attorney and many prominent citizens of the county, asking for a pardon, and setting forth the fact that he had borne a good reputation prior to his arrest, was an industrious citizen, and has been adequately punished for an offense the results of which were not very harmful. Upon this showing the Governor issued the pardon as asked for .
