Additional Information

Maroni Naphtali Fuller was the son of Josiah Fuller and Catherine Laur (Warren). His siblings were John, Josiah, Benjamin W., and Sarah Fuller.

Maroni's father Josiah Fuller was killed at the Haun's Mill massacre in where 17 Mormon men died in an attack in eastern Caldwell County, Missouri. by a mob/militia unit from Livingston County, Missouri. This was part of the 1838 Mormon War in Missouri. His mother remarried to William Warren.

Maroni N Fuller a farmer living in Littleton, Schuyler County, Illinois enlisted at the age of 24 on 19 July 1862 as a Private in Co G, 73 Illinois US Infantry for a period of 3 years. He Mustered In on 21 August 1862 at Camp Butler, Sangamon County, Illinois and Mustered Out on 22 June 1865 at Quincy, Adams County, Illinois. He had been in the Hospital at Quincy since December 1864.
