George W. Hall, 20 born in Cumberland County, New Jersey and single living in Saratoga, Marshall County, Illinois enlisted as a Private in Co E, 86th Illinois US Infantry on 15 August 1862 at Saratoga, Illinois. He was 5' 10" with black hair and blue eyes working as a farmer. He mustered in 27 August 1862 at Peoria, Peoria County, Illinois. He was promoted to a Corporal 1 August 1864 and mustered out 6 June 1865 at Washington DC.

George's son Willis was a Captain with 248 Coast Artillery, Washington State National Guard, Medical Department Detachment, Seattle.

George Hall's grandfather Levi Barrett Hall was a veteran of the Revolutionary War.
