Civil War Service Records

Enlisted 29 March 1862 at Lewisburg, Greenbrier County, Virginia (now West Virginia), captured at the Battle of Lewisburg 23 May 1862, discharged from the General Hospital at Gallipolis, Ohio 2 July 1862, received at the Military Prison at Wheeling, Virginia (Athenaeum Prison) 5 July 1862, sent to Camp Chase, Ohio in August 1862, sent from Camp Chase to Vicksburg to be exchanged 25 August 1862, surrendered as a deserting rebel at Charlestown, West Virginia in March 1865, took the Amnesty Oath 20 March 1865 and sent to the Military Prison at Wheeling, West Virginia 24 April 1865.

William's son, Franklin August Hantsbarger, was a Bugler in WWI with Co E, 864th US Infantry and is buried at Los Angeles National Cemetery. Served 18 September 1917 to 29 April 1919.

William's daughter Bernice married Earl P Hamilton son of John Hamilton a Civil War Veteran also buried in Orange County.
