Student at Medical Department of the Iowa State University. Received his M.D. degree in 1877.

**Professional Life**

Dr. Hasson was an active member in all the communities he served as physician in. He was Clerk and Recorder of Union County, South Dakota, Superintendent of Norfolk Hospital in Nebraska, as well as, being a Trustee of the Buena Park School System. He was also member of the California Legislature in 1900 and 1901.

Mrs. Hanson donated her books to create a lending library that became the Buena Park Library.
