Henry K Hoff 22, single blacksmith living in Tallula, Menard County, Illinois enlisted as a Private in Co F, 114th Illinois US Infantry on 11 August 1862 for a period of 3 years. Born in Mercer County, New Jersey he was5' 8 3/4" tall with dark hair and eyes. He mustered in 18 September 1862 at Sprinfield, Illinois and mustered out 3 August 1865 at Vicksburg, Mississippi
