Additional Information

Jesse enlisted 20 April 1862 at Memphis, Tennessee. He was wounded in the back and arm. Jesse appears on a Roll of Prisoners of War of Company E, 2nd Regiment Missouri Volunteer Cavalry, Confederate States Army, commanded by Col. R. McCulloch, surrendered at Citronelle, Alabama, by Lt General R. Taylor, C.S.A. to Maj. Gen. E.R.S. Canby, U.S.A., May 4, 1865 and paroled at Columbus, Mississippi, May 16, 1865. He deserted from the rebel army at Memphis, Tennessee June 2, 1865. Oath of Allegiance to the United States sworn at Memphis, Tennessee June 2, 1865

Jesse Joplin came to Orange County with his wife about 1918. He was a member of Hi Bledsoe Camp, United Veterans of the Confederacy.

Jesse's father, James Joplin, served in Co B, 10th Battalion Heavy Artillery Regiment Virginia.

Jesse's brother, James Benjamin Joplin, served in Co A, 2nd Virginia Cavalry Regiment.

Jesse's brother, Josiah C Joplin, served in Co A, 2nd Cavalry Regiment Virginia and is buried at Santa Ana Cemetery, Orange County.
