In the New York Town Clerk's Register, Judson Eugene Leggett was born 9 August 1844 in Holland, New York to Thomas Leggett and Emeline Morey. He enlisted on 9 August 1862 in Holland, Erie County, New York for the 116<sup>th</sup> Infantry, Co I as a Private. He was promoted to Corporal on 4 September 1862, and to full Sergeant on 12 April 1864. He mustered out on 8 June 1865 at Washington, DC.

E. J. Leggett was County Surveyor of Lowell County, Kansas and was elected Superintendent of Schools in 1880. He also became a member of the County High School board. He came to Orange County about 1910.

Judson's brother, Pulaski Leggett was a Sergeant with Co I, 116<sup>th</sup> New York Infantry

Judson's grandsons, Charles Earl Leggett and Charles Warren Vickers were Veterans of World War I.
