Enlisted in Company D, 15th New York Heavy Artillery 9 January 1865 at Tarrytown, New York, mustered out 22 August 1865 at Washington D.C. After the war, George apparently served in the U.S. Army in Company C, 15th Infantry, Company A, 17th Infantry and Company A, 35th Infantry.
