Illinois Civil War Detail Report

Eugene Maddison, a farmer, born in Wisconsin and residing in Seneca, McHenry County, Illinois enlisted as a Private in Co A, 153rd Illinois US Infantry on 6 February 1865 at Marengo, Illinois for a period of 1 year. He mustered in 6 February 1865 and mustered out 21 September 1865 at Memphis, Shelby County, Tennessee.
