Illinois Civil War Detail Report

Abe Markle, age 22, residing in Fairbaugh, Livingston County, Illinois and working as a teacher was born in Urichsville, Tuscarawas County, Ohio. He enlisted as a Private, in Co E, 129th Infantry on 8 August 1862 in Fairburgh, Illinois for a period of 3 years. He mustered out on 8 June 1865 in Washington, DC.

Abraham Markle had two brothers who served in the Civil War

- Samuel Johnston Markle observed in Company B of the 30th Ohio Infantry Regiment.
- Jasper Newton Markle served in Company B of the 30th Ohio Infantry Regiment and is also buried in Orange County.
