Wilson F. McClintock, age 18, residing in Lyons, Cook County, Illinois enlisted as a Private with Co H, 127th Illinois US Infantry on 23 July 1862 for a three year period. He mustered in 6 September 1862 and mustered out 5 June 1865 in Washington, DC.

Wilson McClintock served in the same unit with Hiram S. McClintock, his uncle. Captain. Hiram S. McClintock was killed in action at Vicksburg, Mississippi 19 May 1863.

Wilson McClintock's brother, Byron, served in during the Civil War with Co K, 134th Illinois US Infantry.

Wilson's father was one of the first street commissioners of Chicago, Cook County, Illinois

About 1870 Wilson F. McClintock moved to Nebraska, and operated as a store and Post Master for Tipps Branch in Pawnee County. He relocated to Hyde Park, Illinois in the 1883 as a Dry Goods and Postmaster, in Normal Park, Cook County, Illinois in 1884, in Lake City, Illinois in 1885, and 1889 as a grocer, and in Chicago, Illinois as a grocer in 1890 based on City Directories.
