### Illinois Civil War Detail Report

James McCloud 19, a farmer living in Owego, Livingston County, Illinois enlisted as a Private with Co G, 3<sup>rd</sup> Illinois US Cavalry Consolidated on 23 January 1865 at Springfield, Illinois for a period of 1 year. He mustered in 23 January 1865 at Springfield, Illinois and mustered out 10 October 1865 at Fort Snelling, Minnesota.

James' brother, Simeon McCloud, werved with Co F, 138<sup>th</sup> Illinois US Infantry during the Civil War.
