Additional Information

Charles Montgomery enlisted as a Private on 15 February 1864. He mustered in the same day into Co B, Pennsylvania 83rd Infantry. He was listed as wounded at Laurel Hill, Virginia on 8 May 1864. He was transferred to Co E and mustered out 28 June 1865 at Washington, D.C.

Charles Montgomery had two brothers who also enlisted during the Civil War; John B Montgomery with Co A, 139th Pennsylvania Volunteer Infantry and James M Montgomery with Co B, 83rd Regiment, Pennsylvania Infantry.
