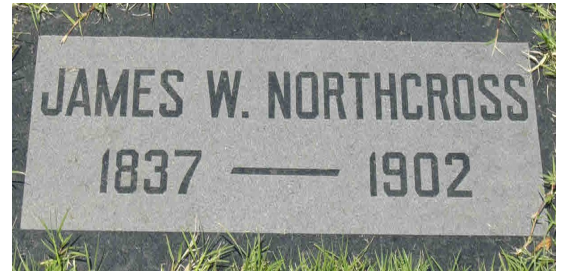

Enlisted 20 June 1862, captured 17 December 1864, discharged 4 June 1865. He was captured near Franklin, Tennessee 17 December 1864. He was received at the Military Prison, Louisville, Kentucky 2 January 1865. He was transferred to Camp Chase, Ohio 4 January 1865 and was paroled and transferred to Point Lockout, Maryland 17 February 1865 for exchange. He was received at Wayside Hospital or General Hospital No. 9 Richmond, Virginia 28 February 1865.
