Amos Bachman a resident of Washington County, Indiana enlisted on 19 August 1863 as a Private in Co G, 117th Indiana Infantry. He mustered out 25 February 1864 at Indianapolis, Indiana.

Amos Bachman spent his winters at the home of his daughter, Vesta Ingle, in Santa Ana. It was during one of this visits that he passed away. During his time in Orange County he was active with the Local GAR Post.

He was a member of GAR Sedgwick Post No 17, Santa Ana, Orange County, California
