## Additional Information

Edmund Badley served with Co F, 15<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment Mississippi. He enlisted as a Private 8 May 1862. He was captured 17 December 1864 at Franklin, Tennessee. He signed an Oath of Allegiance to the United States at Camp Chase, Ohio 13 June 1865.

Edmund Badley while born in England lived most of his life in Mississippi until he relocated to Orange County, California about 1920. There is a newspaper notice in the Santa Ana Register, May 25, 1925 that Edmund Badley was traveling to Memphis, Tennessee and vicinity where he had a cotton plantation.
