Additional Information

At the age of 18 Alfred Q Brown living in Branch County, Michigan enlisted on 24 August 1861 as a Private in Co H, 11th Infantry Michigan. He mustered in 28 August 1861 and mustered out 30 September 1864 at Sturgis, Michigan.

After his marriage in 1870 he returned to Michigan and completed the course at Ann Arbor Medical School and practiced medicine in Chicago. He was also active with the Chicago Post Office. He lived in Laguna Beach for 10 years. At the time of his death he was buried at Central Memorial Park now called Westminster Memorial Park, Orange County, California. However, his body was subsequently moved to Memorial Park Cemetery in Battle Creek, Michigan
