## Additional Information

Charles E Buell, a resident of Linn, Walworth County, Wisconsin, enlisted as a Sergeant on 15 August 1862. He mustered into Co C, 22<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Wisconsin on the same date. He was promoted to 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant on 4 February 1863, 1<sup>st</sup> Lieutenant on 21 March 1864 and Captain on 11 May 1864. He mustered out on 12 June 1865 at Washington, D.C.

He worked in the banking business in Lake Geneva, Wisconsin. After which he took up watch making in Illinois. In 1896 he moved to a ranch in Santa Ana, Orange County, California where he lived for about 15 years. He moved to Hollywood, Los Angeles County, California and became an active member in the Octogenarian Society for which he held many offices.
