Charles Chandler, 23, a resident of Marion, Linn County, Iowa enlisted as a Private on 1 July 1861.

He mustered into Co A, 6<sup>th</sup> Iowa Infantry on 17 July 1861. He was promoted to Corporal on 1 January 1864. He re-enlisted on 26 January 1864. He was promoted to Sergeant 30 April 1865 and mustered out on 21 July 1865 at Louisville, Jefferson County, Kentucky

Member of GAR, Gordon Granger Post 138, Orange County, California, Post Commander

In 1905 Charles Chandler was the Recorder for the City of Orange
