## Additional Information

Henry F Culver, age 25, enlisted 23 July 1862 at Troy, New York as a Private in Co G, 1<sup>st</sup> Mounted Rifles. He mustered in 5 August 1862 for a period of three years. He transferred to Co E and then on October 1862 transferred to Co K. He was captured near West Point, Virginia 5 June 1864 and released 28 April 1865 at Jacksonville, Florida. He mustered out 22 June 1865 at New York City.

Imprisoned at Andersonville. Story states during a prisoner exchange, Henry Culver drew a number allowing him to be set free. However, as he was unmarried, he gave his winning number to another prisoner who had a family.
