Additional Information

George A W Faust, age 18, enlisted on 10 September 1864 as a Private with Co C, 182nd Infantry Ohio. He mustered in on 7 October 1864 and mustered out 18 May 1865 at Hospital No 14, Nashville, Tennessee.

George's father, John F Faust, served as a Private with Co I, 42nd Ohio Infantry during the Civil War.

George Faust's family move to Ohio when he was a young boy. While living in Ohio the Civil War broke out and joined the Ohio 182nd Infantry. After the war he moved to Kansas via Illinois. He married Lucinda McKay in Wilson County, Kansas.

The family moved to California in 1876 first settling in Tulare County. While there George became an Engineer for the Southern Pacific Railroad. A job he held for 34 years. The family moved to Tustin, Orange County, California in 1895 and finally to Santa Ana, Orange County, California in 1896.
