Frank E Graves, age 18, enlisted on 18 August 1864 at Tompkins, Delaware County, New York as a Private. He mustered into Co A, New York 144th Infantry. He transferred out on 6 October 1864 and transferred into Co C, New York 1st Engineers at Norwich, Chenango County, New York. He was promoted to Artificer on 1 March 1865. He mustered out 3 July 1865 at Hilton Head, Beaufort County, South Carolina.

Resident of Santa Ana for 21 years.
