John N Hearn (Original filed as John N Herron), a resident of Edgar County, Illinois, enlisted as a Private on 10 September 1861. He mustered into Co E, Illinois 66<sup>th</sup> Infantry on 10 October 1861. He was discharged for disability on 9 July 1862 at Corinth, Mississippi.

Enlisted 22 February 1865 into Co C, 11<sup>th</sup> Infantry Indiana. He mustered out 26 July 1865 at Baltimore, Maryland.
