Fred Klockenteger, a resident of Dayton, Webster County, Iowa, enlisted as a Private at the age of 22 on 24 August 1861. He mustered into Co E, Iowa 10<sup>th</sup> Infantry on 6 September 1861. He was wounded on 16 May 1863 at Champion Hill, Mississippi. He mustered out 28 September 1864 at Kingston, Bartow County, Georgia.
