Hiram C Page, a resident of Williamstown, Dodge County, Wisconsin, enlisted as a Musician on 15 August 1862. He mustered into Co C, 29<sup>th</sup> Wisconsin Infantry on the same day. He was mustered out on 22 June 1865 at Shreveport, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

Member of GAR, Sedgwick Post No 17, Orange County, California

William B Page, Hiram's father, was a Musician with Co A, 7<sup>th</sup> Infantry Wisconsin from 15 July 1861 to 12 September 1863 when he transferred to the Veteran Reserve Corps.
