Charles R Slaysman, age 22, enlisted as a Private on 24 August 1862 at Indiana County, Pennsylvania. He mustered into Co H, Pennsylvania 23rd Infantry. He was transferred out on 23 August 1864 and was mustered into Co E, Pennsylvania 82nd Infantry. He was mustered out on 13 July 1865 at Hall's Hill, Arlington County, Virginia.
