The 15<sup>th</sup> Missouri Volunteer Infantry was organized in St. Louis, Missouri August – September 1861 for a period of 3 yrs. It was involved in the battles of Chickamauga, Missionary Ridge, Pea Ridge, the Atlanta Campaign, and the Siege of Atlanta to name of few. Charles Wagner re-enlisted in the unit after his three years was up the Spring of 1864. Charles Wagner was with Sherman's troops in Sherman's March to the Sea. The unit mustered out of service at Victoria, Texas on 25 December 1865.

After the war Charles returned to St. Louis and worked as a barber. In 1875 he moved to Los Angeles, California again taking up the barber's trade. He then engaged in the grape industry and by 1890 was living in Placentia, Orange County, California.
