Murray's father, Robert D Patton, served with Co D, 45th Ohio Volunteer Infantry during the Civil War. As a skilled blacksmith by trade he was appointed the role of regimental blacksmith and mechanic in the quartermaster's department. He also assisted with the ambulance corps during his service.
