U.S. National Homes for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers. Mr. Rowan was admitted on December 8, 1888 to the Pacific Branch of the National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers (Sawtelle). He is listed as a Carpenter who was released at his own request on June 26, 1889.
