Illinois Civil War Detail Report

George N Shore 38 and born in Huntington County, Tennessee, enlisted as a Private in Co C, 75th Illinois US Infantry on 27 March 1865 at Dixon, Illinois for a period of one year. At the time he was a carpenter residing in Fair Haven, Carroll County, Illinois. He mustered in 28 March 1865. He transferred to HQ 4th Army Corp with the 21st Illinois US infantry 7 June 1865. He mustered out San Antonio, Texas 16 December 1865.
