Additional Information

H.N. Short of Leavenworth, Kansas, served for 14 days with the Kansas State Militia from 13 October 1863 to 26 Oct 1864.

Harvey N. Short was a photographer working in Leavenworth, Kansas for Alfred Shea Addis in 1863 and 1864. Harvey moved to California around 1874 and was a partner in the Anaheim, California gallery of Addis and Short.

Harvey Newton Short was the publisher of the Weekly Herald from 1879 to 1882. After he left the Herald, he started his own paper in 1881 to be called the Santa Ana Herald. If any papers were published it is not known. A year later Harvey Newton Short and W. D. Morton left Santa Ana to start the Pomona Times. W.D. Morton became the editor of the Santa Ana Blade.
