Illinois Civil War Detail Report

Samuel R Smith age 25, married and born in Lake County, Ohio enlisted 26 July 1862 as a Private with Co B 83rd Illinois US Infantry for a period of 3 years. A farmer living in Sumner, Warren County, Illinois he mustered in 21 August 1862 at Monmouth, Warren County, Illinois and mustered out 26 June 1865 at Nashville, Davidson County, Tennessee.
