Illinois Civil War Detail Report

James Stone age 23, native of England enlisted as a Private in Co A, 9th Illinois US Cavalry on 1 September 1861 for a period of 3 years. He was living in Carbon Cliff, Rock Island County, Illinois and working as a farmer at time of enlistment. He mustered in 18 September 1861 at Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. He mustered out 23 September 1864 at Springfield, Illinois.

James Stone arrived in the United States in the 1850's. He first lived in Rutland County, Vermont and then moved to Rock Island County, Illinois. In 1861 he enlisted in Co A, 9th Illinois Cavalry for a period of three years. When he was discharged he returned to Henry County, Illinois eventually moving to Kansas in 1869. In Kansas he farmed and raised stock in Kansas until 1898. At that time he relocated to Southern California. James' parents immigrated in 1856 moving to Rutland County, Vermont.
