Illinois Civil War Detail Report

Henry Wayman age 18, a farmer born in Jo Daviess County, Illinois enlisted as a Private in Co A, 96th Infantry Regiment 15 October 1864 at Dixon, Illinois for a period of one year. He mustered in 16 October 1864. He transferred 1 January 1865 to Co B, 21st Infantry Regiment for a period of one year and mustered out 15 October 1865 at Victoria, Texas.
