Additional Information

Very little information is available for George Williams. In his death notice his friends indicated that he fought in the Civil War for the state of Delaware. An article in the Anaheim Gazette dated June 4, 1881, indicated that he was one of the first four Civil War Veterans buried at Anaheim Cemetery. The burial record indicated that he died of heart disease. One Delaware soldier named George Williams was a prisoner at Andersonville and was hospitalized at Richmond. We have not been able to determine a connection to this veteran.
