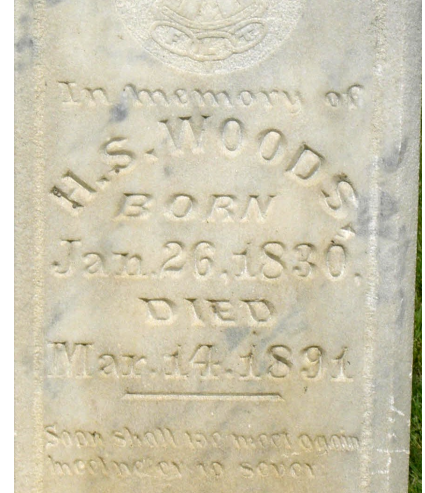

Member of Sedgwick Post No 17, GAR – Post Commander

Enlisted as a Private 27 April 1861 in Co I, 19th Regiment Ohio Volunteer Militia for a period of 3 months. He was at the battle of Rich Mountain, Virginia on 12 July 1861 and was mustered out 30 August 1861. He then enlisted as a Private in Co G, 1st Regiment Ohio Light Artillery for a period of 3 years. He was in the battles of Pittsburg Landing, Stone River, Hoovers Gap, Chickamauga and Mission Ridge. He enlisted again 1 January 1864 for a period of 3 years. He was discharged 31 August 1865.
