New York Passenger List for March 1, 1872 lists a Captain and Mrs. E. N. Zerman departing Aspinwall, Panama for New York. Occupation of Captain E. N. Zerman, Mexican Army.

New York passport application in 1866 for an Emanuel Zerman born in Moscow, lists his father as Brigadier General John Zerman.
