THE PLANTAGENET DESCENT FROM THE CID

Owing to the peculiar social structure of mediaeval Tudor England an appreciable number of the 17th century settlers of English North America were descended from the mediaeval baronage of England and from the Plantagenet kings. The Plantagenet descents are chiefly from the earlier members of the family, through Edward I, but there are also members from his grandson Edward 3rd. These have long been of interest to American genealogists but the earlier workers were not mediaevalists or familiar with the record of the period, so that, while they produced much valuable work, their work must be carefully checked. In the last forty years a group of competent mediaevalists have arisen in this country whose work is of great value in this field. Also in the same field a large number of able workers have appeared in the English history, followers of the great English mediaevalists, Dr. I. Horace Round; at the same time a number of outstanding scholars have been working in continental Europe: France, Spain, Germany, and Italy; and some have been working in the Argentine.

The work of American antiquaries, while dealing with descents from the Plantagenets and from Charlemagne, have not gone into, to any great extent, the maternal ancestries of the Plantagenet kings, which were largely from Continental families extending from Russia and Byzantium to Spain and the Crusading houses of Outremer. Lt. H. Turton's "The Plantagenet Ancestry" (London 1928) is a valuable work, which, however, must be used with caution and carefully checked for erroneous lines. Since then, much new information has come to light through the labors of distinguished Continental scholars as Prof. Brandenburg's *Die Nachkommen Karl des Grossen* (Leipzig, 1935), in which is given fourteen generations of Charlemagne's descendants to about 1200.

The present paper deals with the proved descent of Queen Eleanor of Castile first wife of Edward I, from the great Spanish eleventh century hero of the Reconquista, Rodrigo Diaz, Señor de Bivar, Conde de Valencia, *El Campeador* (ca 1042-1099). The great work of the noted Spanish scholar, Ramon Menendez Pidal, *La Espana del Cid* (1929) and of his predecessor Prof. Reinhardt Pieter Anne Dozy, *Historia de musulmanes de Espana* (4 vols., 1920-1931), have thrown a flood of light upon the career of the famous Spanish hero of romance and poetry. He is now shown as he was, a famous leader and warrior, with a will to gain all he could, but not quite the great Christian champion depicted in the Spanish mediaeval romances and chronicles.

Rodrigo Diaz came of a line of Castilian nobles, perhaps not of the highest rank, but sufficiently distinguished to have held the office of Juez (Judge) in Castile. He was strongly opposed to the absorption of Castile by the Kings of Leon. Banished from Castile he gathered a mixed following of Christians and Moors, and took service with the Moorish King. At this period Spain presented a very confused picture; Christians of the North in constant war with the Moors of the South and with each other. The Moslems of the south present a similar picture. Turning against the Moors, Diaz captured Valencia from them and ruled as Count. He was besieged by a great Moorish Army, died during the siege in July 1099; his followers were compelled to surrender the city. His title of Cid is derived from the Arabic word *Syyid* (still used as *Sid* in Egypt) meaning Master. It was given him by his Moorish followers and he was styled "*El Campeador*" (the Challenger) from his habit of engaging in single combat before a general engagement. According to the Spanish tradition, when Valencia was surrendered, his followers dressed his body in

full armor, mounted him on his great horse, Baviacca, and led him forth at their head. Ruy Diaz ("El Cid") was buried in the church of St. Pedro at Cardena, near Burgos, where his tomb may still be seen.

It was formerly held that Eleanor of Provence, Queen of Henry 3rd, was a descendent of the Cid but recent research has proved that this is not correct. However, the descent of her daughter in law, Eleanor of Castile, first wife of Edward 1, is well established.
