Suter and their children free from the controls of their present or any future husband, during the lives of my said daughters and at their deaths to their children or the issue of their children--The said estate so given in trust for my said two daughters to be one half to each and to be ultimately divided among their children and the issue of such children accordingly. And my executors are herein empowered and directed that should any of my slaves become unmanageable so that the interest of my estate ~~should~~ shall so require, to sell the said slave or slaves and to hold the proceeds subject to the trusts herein before declared or to any others as they shall deem most prudent -- holding the same subject to the trusts aforesaid.

4. I nominate and appoint ^{Burwell} ~~Burwell~~ Davis and Matthew Whitaker both of Halifax County, No. Carolina, my executors to this my last will and testament--hereby ~~making~~ ^{revoking} all other wills by me heretofore made.

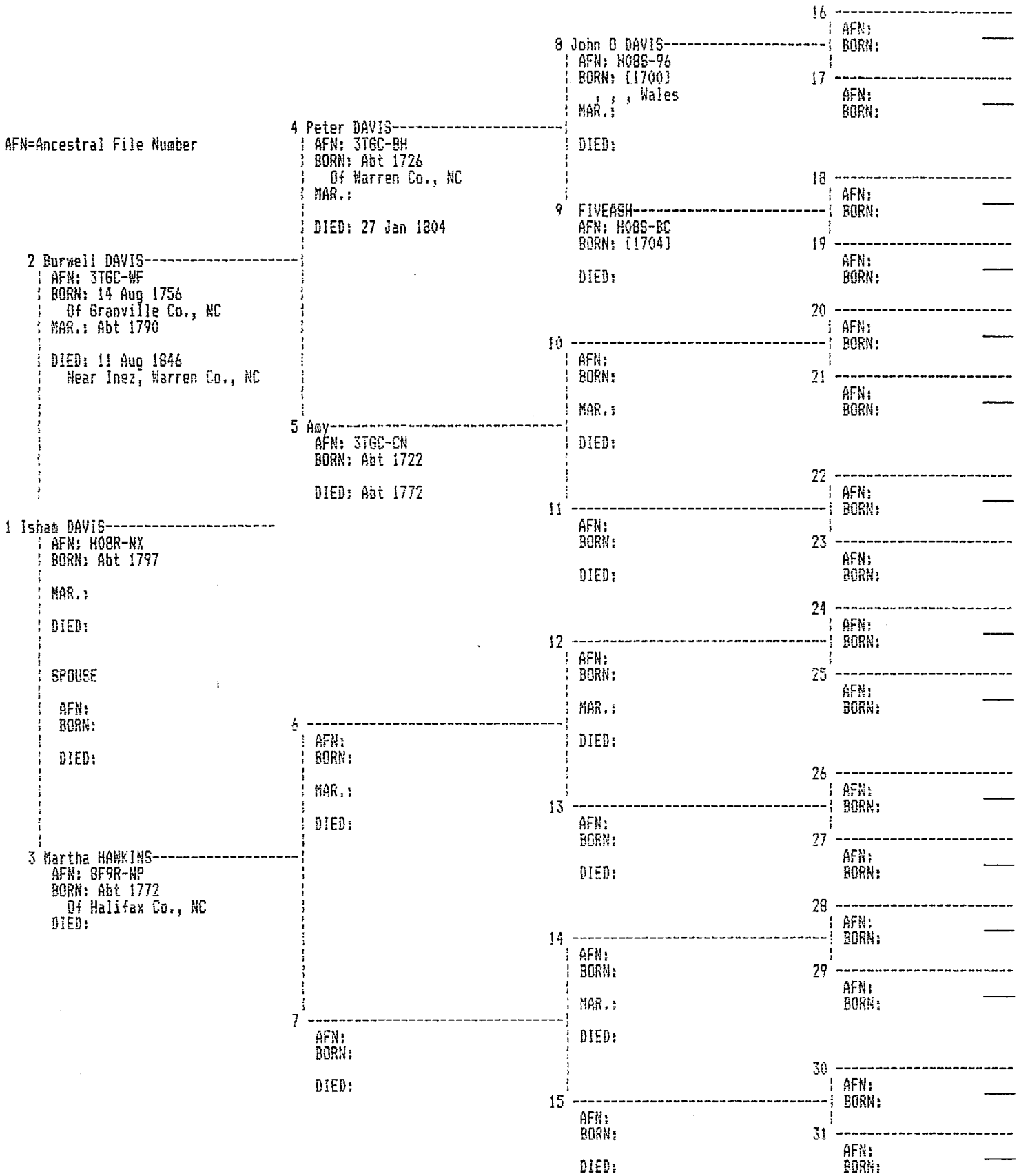





Sir:—

Your communication under date of the 24th ult. in relation to the Pension claim of Lemima Thompson, widow of Charles Thompson, late of N. C., reached me by last mail; and in answer to your inquiry; "Was she the first wife of the Pensioner or had he been married before?", I have to state that he had been married before. At the time of the second marriage to Lemima Hardy, the present Petitioner, he was a widower. The only issue of the first marriage was one son, John; who removed to this state from N. C., and died in this county eight years ago. The son John left a widow who is still living in this county, Mary Thompson, and also three children, two sons and a daughter, John B., Charles A. & Ann C. John B. lives in Jonesville, Ala. Charles A. resides in this county, & Ann C. married a Mr. Stoner, who is now in California but his wife, Ann C. is in Habersham Co. Ga.

I am thus particular in giving you the lineal descendants of the old Pensioner not knowing the legal object of the inquiry. I am not aware that either the act of Congress of July 29. 1848. or the act of Feb. 3. 1853, (under which Lemima Thompson demands a pension), or the published Regulations of the Pension Office of March 25. 1853, containing directions for carrying into effect the

latter act, makes it necessary to state whether or not
a widow claiming under that act was the first or
second wife of the deceased Revolutionary pensioner,
or whether or not he had ever been married before;
but I cheerfully comply with your request, presuming
there is some back pay as pension, due the heirs
of Charles Thompson, the deceased Pensioner, he not
having drawn fully up to the time of his death.

The facts, as above stated, I get from the
said Charles A., Grand son of the old Pensioner; and
tho' I do not know that the statement is correct, from
the circumstances, I presume they are, as set down.

If legal proof of all or any of the facts should
be required, on being notified as to who must
be established, I will endeavor to furnish the
Department with such evidence.

The early attention of the Pension
Office to the claim of Mrs. Lemima Thompson
is most respectfully solicited, as she is very poor, &
as I believe her claim is most meritorious.

I forgot to say in the proper connection that
there was no issue from the second marriage
of the old Pensioner with Lemima Hardy. They were
both old & had no more children - so I am informed.

- That she does not now remember under the command of what officer or officers he so served. She further states that he was honorably discharged from said service, but does not know where or when, and that if he ever had a written discharge, she does not know where it is, or what became of it.

She further states that she was married to the said Charles Thompson, in Rutherford County in the state of North Carolina, in the month of November sometime about the year 1826, and that her name before her said marriage, was Semina Hardy - That her said husband died about the second day of April A. D. 1836, in the said county in which he was at the time & place of said marriage in the state of North Carolina - That she has never married since the death of her said husband, and that she is now a widow.

He entered the service of the United States in the Spring of 1781 in Lenoir County North Carolina (now Rutherford County) enlisted under Capt Johnson, Lieutenant, Samuel Jackson, a Cavalry Company in the Regiment of Col Middleton. Marched to Brown's fields in North Carolina on the Congaree River after remaining there for some time, marched to Camden in the same State, from thence to Orangeburg in the same State, from thence to a place called the fourth Bridge— thence back to Orangeburg & was there dismissed after having served for ten months, & received a written discharge from Capt Waters. The Regiment he served in formed a part of the Army of General Sumpter.
