

In the Name of God amen I Jones Fuller of Franklin County being of sound and perfect Mind and Memory blessed be god Do this First Day of May in the year of our Lord 1812 Do make and publish this my Last Will and testament in manner and form as follows that is to say First I give my Right of all the property as I have give a bond to Peter at my Decease that I had by my Last wife these are her sones in law that is to say Israel Bailey John upchurch and Lo Jackson and I will name them if I can if I forget any the Bond will call for them and I desier they shall have them first I give to these three her sons in law all my Rights of the Land as her former husband left to her his wife I allso give to these sons in law of my wifes as was her Desier to give her part to them insted of her self also 3 beds 8 sheets on 3 coverlids 1 bedsted 3 dishes 2 Basons on six plates 1 Duckoven

1 Chist 1 Cotton wheal 1 pare of Cards 1 pare of tongs 1 shovel 1 old he 2 old axes an 1 Meal Bag and if I have forgot anything I want my Executers to make it unto them 1 womans saddle an bridle also I give to my wife the house I had with her and the Negro man Jacob as long as she lives and as for my Children I have given to them as much as I have for them at presents I give to Isham Fullers Children two hundre Dollars to be Equally Devived between them if they are contended without seeking for any more but if not satisfide to have not at all I give an bequeth to my Daughter Sealy Fullers Children two hundred Dollars to be Equilly Devived betwen them al but her son Jones an her son Henry them I give the Land to that arthur Fuller now lives on to be Devived betwen them

Item I give to my son Archey Fuller my Negro boy calld Sam

Item I give to my son Bartholemew Fuller 1 Negro named Ben thefe to my son Henry Jones an Sara Holt I hav given two Negros a peace before an Zilley Miller 2 Negros before I give to my son Demcy Fuller 1 Negro woman by the name of Tamer I give to my Daughter Milley Yarbrough 1 Negro garl calld Jany I give to my Daughter Mary Jurdan the child my Negro woman cald ab is now big with if the Child lives and I lend to Mary Jurdan the Negro garl cald Lender while Fanny Marys or Comes of age

Item I give to my Daughter Ollif Bailey my young filley Cald the the Rock filley and one hundred Dollers to said ollif Bailey

Note a Beni I give upto these three sons in law of my wifes eighty three pounds an som shillings as the Bond Calls for as I sold my wifes property for she would have it Returnd to them insted of herself

I give to my Daughter Faney Fuller 1 Negro girl named Lender the same garl I lent to Mary Jordan while Faney come of age or married I also give to my daughter Faney 1 Negro boy calld Sondy and I give her 1 Bed and furniture 1 womans saddle an bridle and 1 cow and calf 1 sow an pigs 1 pot 1 dish six spoons six plates an 1 case of knives an forks and a knof to by her 1 good sute of cloths

Item I give to my son Worrin Fuller 1 Negro boy calld Jacob and garl calld Pat and 1 horse I had of my son Ephraim and my brand colt 1 saddle an bridle to 1 cow an calf 2 sows an pigs my small shot gun an my Muskit I also give this Land an plantation whereon I live to my son Worrin Fuller after taking of what I want for Epraim and for Jordan only Fanney Fuller is to have a house and home as long as she lives single or comes of age and I give my Desk to my son Warrin and the other Desk to Faney as was her momeys and to Warrin I give him money aknof to by him a good sute of cloths

Item I give to my son Johnnathan Fuller forty acres of land lying in the fork of the Creek above Daniel Fullers an joines George Williams and I give to said Johnnathan 1 Negro woman cald Grace the land I give to my son Ephraim begins on little River bilo his house runs up the River to my Spring Branch then up the Branch to the Cole branch to Jeffries line then down that line strait to the first station the Land I give to my son Jordan Fuller is all the track I had of Jene XXX Pearces and where he the said Jordan now lives down the River to the first Branch above my upper field on the River strait on North XXXXX Corse from the River to Michal Dents Line I Desier that Solomon Stephen Dave an Middlton Luce an Abl an Beck an ann an leer Continu on the plantation under the command of my son Warrin Fuller and for the supovrt of said Worrin an Fanney Fuller to be seen to by my Executers to be an overseer over these Negros untill Worrin an Fanney marries or comes of age then I give Midlton to my son Alsay Fuller and I give Stephen to my son Ephraim Fuller and I give Dave to my son Jordan Fuller and after these last children comes of age I want all the property I have to be sold and equilly divided that is all I own at my deceas all that Worrin can gain from my diseas untill he comes of age is to be devived betwen he an Fanney only I want XXX Ollif Bailey to have 1 side saddle an Bridle 2 yews and lambs an Worrin 2 yoes an lambs an Fanney 2 yoes an lambs and Johnnathan 2 yoes an lambs I also give to Demcy Fuller Fifty Dollars at my Deceace or before if it can be made I allso leave Luce and Abl Luce to Worrin and Abl to Fanney Fuller as there own Right I allso give my black mares filley to my Daughter Fanney as her own Right and all the gease I have at my deceas to be equilly devived betwen my son Worrin Fuller an my Daughter Fanney Fuller I also give 1 large pott and 1 Duck oven to Worrin an 1 large pott an 1 Duck oven to my Daughter Fanney Fuller after my son Worrin and Daughter Fanney Comes of age I give my Negro garl calld Easter to my Daughter Polley Jordan and at the same time I give to my Daughter Ollieff Bailey my Negro woman calld Ann al my stock of horses cattle and sheep an hoggs Remaining over an above after my just debts paid and Lands if any to be sold an equilly devived amongst all my living children and as I have tried to devide all betwen my children an wife I now make and ordain these worthey friends an sons of mine Bartholemew Fuller Epraim Fuller an Worrin Fuller Executers of this my last will an testament wherein I set my hand an seal the day and year first above writon signed sealed published and declared by the said Jones Fuller the testater to be his last will an testament in the presents of us who were present at the time of signing and sealing thereof


