Spec #10, name of father is given as Wilms, but elsewhere Dawn has seen it as Wilman. Margaret came from Germany ca. 1865?

Spec #14 - Informant - Mrs. F. H. Brugge was almost for sure Mrs. Fred H. Brugge. Dawn's mother, Catherine Hiskey Cremlay, spoke of Fred + Ethel Brugge who she knew when she was young. They lived in Los Angeles. I believe Ethel was a child of one of Charles Schultzy's sisters. She would be first cousin of Genevieve M. M. Schultzy Hiskey. Fred + Ethel were also listed in L.A. city directories, early 1900's.
